DIAN CHÚRSA ARDTEISTE 2019 (2 Week Course) Fee €690 (Course J)

A stand alone Intensive preparation course for students sitting Leaving Certificate 2019. Special emphasis on topics for papers 1 & 2 and in particular on the Oral Irish exam. Recorded Mock Oral examinations will be conducted throughout with feedback given on all aspects to ensure success.

14 Day Gaeltacht Experience Course (Courses D, E & F)

This course is designed for Pre-Junior Cert students who wish to experience the Gaeltacht for a reduced period at a reduced rate (€690 instead of €910).

College rules will be explained clearly to students on their first day.

3. Smoking is forbidden on the course.
4. Students must not absent themselves from the guesthouses after 10.00 p.m. and remain there until after breakfast.
5. Swimming/fishing is only allowed under the supervision of a member of college staff.
6. A student may not leave the college during the course without the permission of the Príomhoide.
7. As with normal school discipline policies misbehaviour, verbal or physical intimidation, intentional or otherwise will be dealt with accordingly by the college authorities.
8. The Coláiste does not accept responsibility for lost/stolen or damaged property during the course. Students must make good any damage to property in guest-house or college before course completion.
